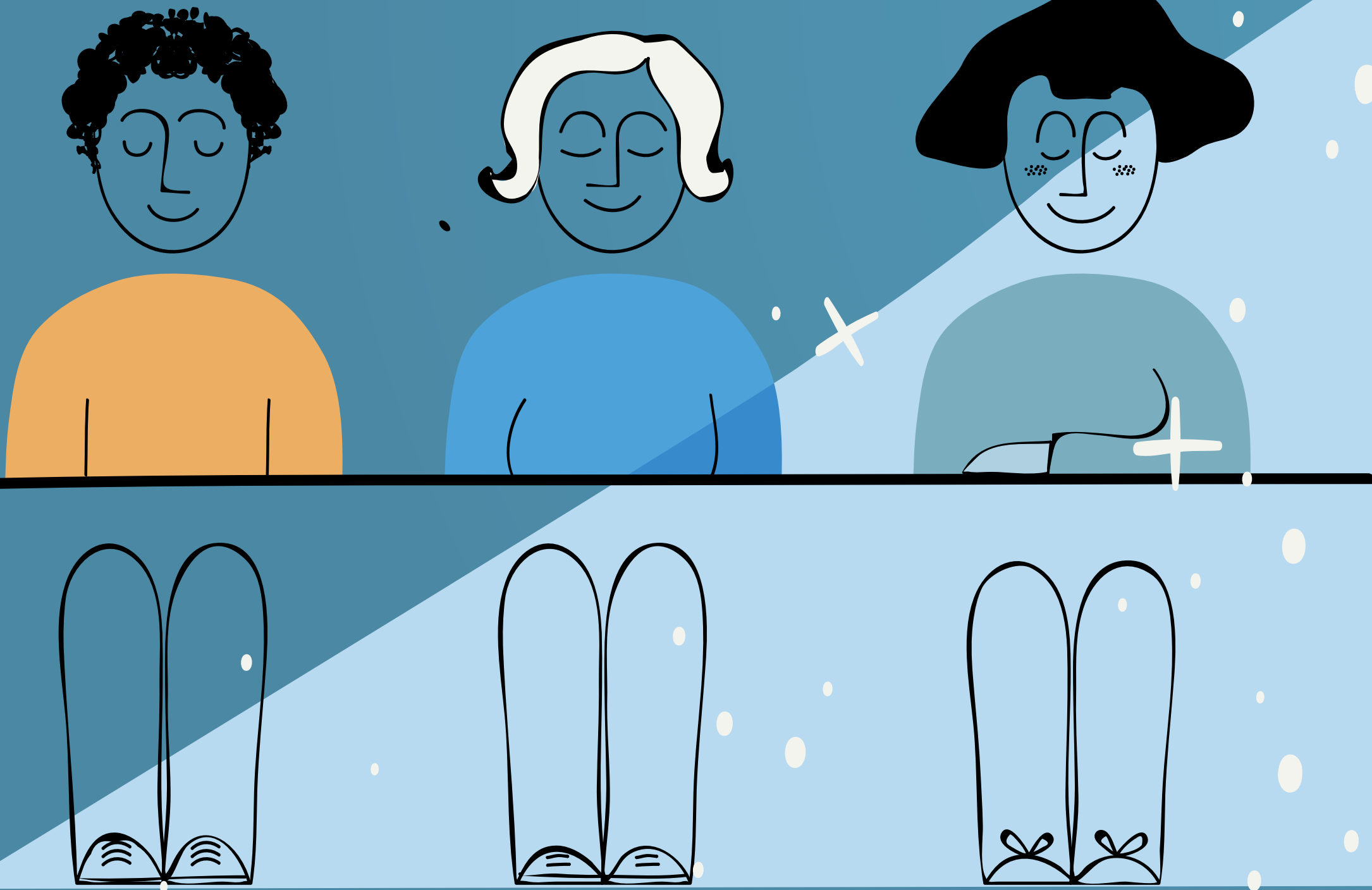

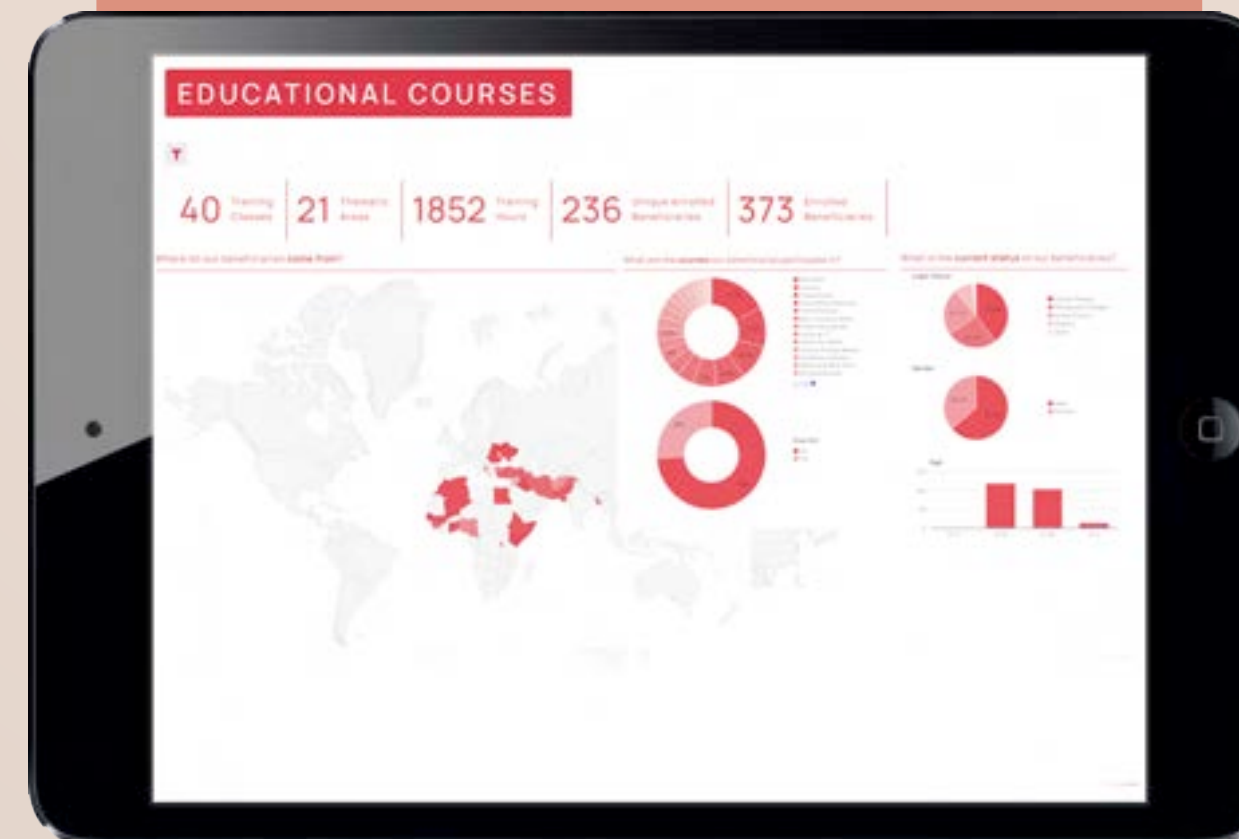
BENEFICIARIES
